No.	Question	Answer/Clarification
1.	On expired good conduct what should be provided since new certificates are not yet out?	The expired Good conduct plus proof of application for renewal is acceptable.
2.	Those with TSV Vehicles, are they eligible to bid?	A TSV license is acceptable in place of PSV.
3.	Special group categories wanted 20 slots to be shared among the YAGPO, AGPO and PWD.	The award will be to the highest financial bidder in this special category. There will therefore be a common tariff for taxi operators that will be adopted.
4.	Special group exemption from experience.	Minimum Experience, Special Group - 3 years relevant experience.
5.	The total number of vehicles for this category is 50. Is this the number of vehicles that each bidder is to provide, or is it the total number for entire lot?	This is the total number each bidder should provide.
