QUERY	RESPONSE
1. Clarify whether new bidders who did not attend the first site visit (9 th August 2019) will be allowed to enter the bidding process by virtue of attending the second site visit.	Bidders who did not attend the first site visit (9 th August 2019) will be allowed to enter the bidding process by virtue of attending the second site visit.
2. Clarify whether the Bidders who attended the first site visit but are unable to attend the second site visit will remain eligible.	Bidders who attended the first site visit but were unable to attend the second site visit will remain eligible to participate.
3. Is the tender open to foreign contractors?	This tender is open to citizen contractors only. Citizen Contractor means a person or a firm wholly owned and controlled by persons who are citizens of Kenya.
4. In which form should the tender security be?	The Tender Security shall be in one of the following forms: a) Cash; b) A Bank Guarantee; c) An Insurance Bond issued by an insurance firm approved by the PPOA located in Kenya;

	d) An irrevocable letter of credit issued by a reputable bank.
5. We request for an extension for the closing/opening of tender.	The closing/opening date remains as 23 rd October, 2019 at 11.00 a.m. The venue is at the Conference Room, 1 st Floor, Kenya Airports Authority Headquarters Complex Building as per Addendum No. 4.
