If you have ever been contracted by KAA and performed poorly in contract(s)/or been terminated in contract(s) you need not apply; the bids will not be considered b. have two (2) ongoing projects you need not apply, the bids will not be considered	Bidders are hereby informed that this requirement is expunged and shall not be use as evaluation criteria
3.	In tender No. KAA/OT/MIA/0176/2023-2024 which is a tender for the proposed repairs and replacement for apron flood lights at Moi International Airport, mandatory requirement No. 17 requires an EPRA licence B- on Electrical and above whereas your scope of work does not necessitate this class of registration according to energy Act 2017.	Bidders are hereby advised that The works involves repair of cables and floodlights that has a scope of electrical work, thus result in interference with existing electrical systems at the Airport which is complex. This calls for class B contractors and experience of Electrical systems.

It has also been noted that pagination of the tender document are not properly aligned as some pages are duplicated and they contain different information and some pages are also missing, this may mislead the bidders who are submitting their bids; e.g pages 43 has been repeated 3 times and has different information.	Bidders are advised that the tender document has sufficient information to submit a responsive bid
