In the event of a legal issue arising after the bidder has commenced harvesting, how will the bidder be protected? Will there be a provision for refunds?	In line with PPAD, upon notification of award, there will be 14-day grace period for any complaints. Upon the expiry of the grace period, the winning bidders will proceed to make payments to the authority in line with the tender guidelines.
Is the portion at Boma Airstrip subdivided into smaller sections or is it one large block?	It is one block.
Page 15, Table 2 – Harvesting Period: Considering the current rainy weather,	The details in the tender document remains but the authority may review

Can Lots 2, 4, and 6 be reserved specifically for millers residing within Uasin Gishu County?	Reservations as per the tender document remains
Can bidders be allowed to use a bid bond instead of cash for the Reserve Price?	Cash only.
Instead of stating an absolute amount, can the bid bond amount be expressed as a percentage of the reserve price?	The position in the tender document remains.
In the event that a bidder is unsuccessful, how long after the tender process will the reserve price be refunded?	Deposits made to the authority will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders upon the conclusion of the procurement process.
Given the 90-day harvesting timeline, can the permitted working hours be extended beyond 5:00 PM and include weekends?	The details in the tender document remains but the authority may review based on circumstances during the harvesting time.
Is a bidder allowed to submit bids for all available lots?	The bidder shall participate as per the instructions provided in the tender document.
If a bidder wins but fails to pay within the stipulated time frame, Can the bid bond amount paid be forfeited?	Cash deposits made will be forfeited if a bidder is successful and fails to pay the balance within the stipulated time frame as stated in the tender document.
